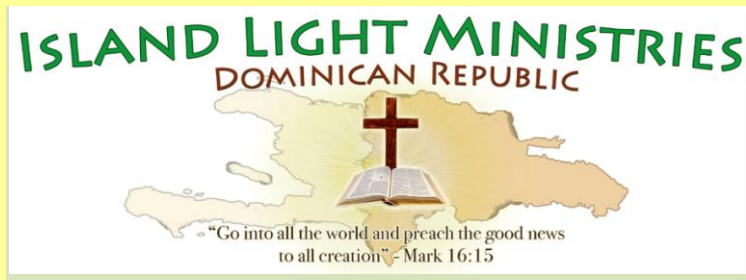
and smiles of the people said it all even if they did not speak a word. Each bag delivered provides 100 servings of soup.

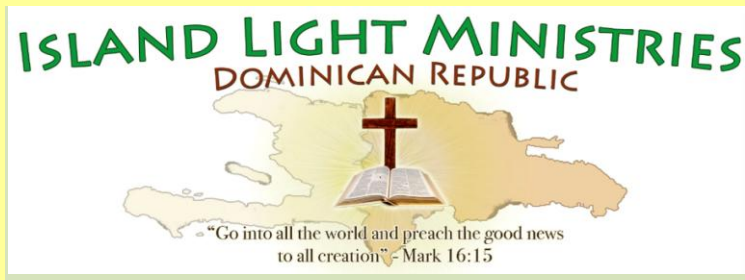
Believing in Christmas for Paraiso

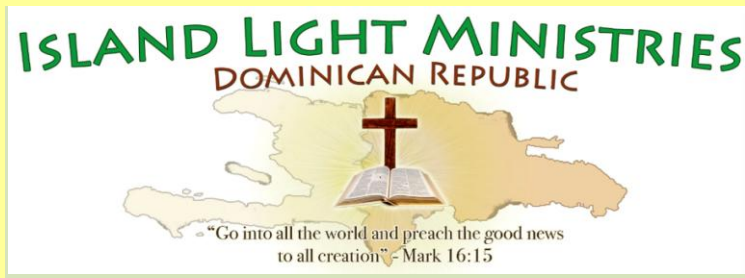
